B. Objectives

The objective of this recruitment is to hire qualified Public Health Officers (PHOs) who will provide coordination and collaboration support in the formulation & implementation of the project activities outlined below.

C. Roles and Responsibilities

The core roles and responsibilities of PHOs are supporting to the designated municipality in implementation of local public health policies by providing technical inputs, creating good synergies between municipality and citizens. Besides, they will provide mentorship support to the health committee members and health workers in close coordination with the municipality. Additionally, PHOs shall frequently be visiting community and wards to bring the emerging community health issues which allows work on promoting accessible and quality health service delivery.

Core responsibilities of the Public Health Officer includes but is not limited to:

- Collaborate closely with the PPP program team on an as-needed basis to support the implementation of project-related activities within the municipality, aiding in the establishment of favorable relations between the program and the municipality.
- Provide mentoring support to organize regular meetings of the Social Development Committee (SDC), Health Facility Operation & Management Committee and other relevant health working committees to promote accessible and quality health service delivery.
- Collaborate with municipal stakeholders including municipal committees, SDC, HFOMC, health officials to gather inputs and ensure policy alignment with local needs and priorities related to public health,
- Coordinate the implementation of public health policies and strategies within the municipality, ensuring adherence to established guidelines and protocols at different levels,
- Monitor the implementation progress and identify any challenges or bottlenecks, proposing appropriate solutions to overcome them.
- Conduct need based capacity-building activities for Local health committee members, Municipal stakeholders, Health Facility Operation and Management Committee health workers, and other relevant stakeholders to enhance their understanding of public health policies and their roles in formulation & implementation of public health policy.

Coordinate data collection activities to gather relevant health information and indicators from

health facility necessary to support for policy planning, development and monitoring.

Analyze collected data to assess the impact and effectiveness of implemented policies and identify areas for improvement.

Prepare reports and presentations summarizing key findings and recommendations based on data analysis.

Maintain close coordination with the health section at the municipality to ensure effective collaboration and communication.

Provide regular monthly reports on the status of policy formulation, implementation, including challenges, successes, and recommendations for improvement.

PHOs shall be required to coordinate with the SNGP Field Coordinator (s) in terms of implementing municipality level activities and report to Municipal health coordinators on regular

PHOs will report their monthly progress report directly to the Project Coordinator of Public Policy Pathshala, establishing a direct reporting line for effective communication and coordination.
